*Re: PJM Interconnection, L.L.C, Docket No. ER19-1599-000*

Dear Secretary Bose:

PJM Interconnection, L.L.C. (“PJM”), pursuant to section 205 of the Federal Power Act,<sup>1</sup> and the Commission’s eTariff filing requirements,<sup>2</sup> hereby submits for filing changes to certain “meta-data” values of parts of the PJM Open Access Transmission Tariff (“Tariff”). PJM is making no revisions to the substance of the tariff records in this filing. Rather, this filing is being made because certain areas of PJM’s eTariff database will soon run out of collation values<sup>3</sup> between Tariff records and PJM will not have the ability to accept new tariff records until new collation values are assigned. PJM requests an effective date of April 18, 2019, one day after the submission of this filing, as this filing does not include substantive revisions to the Tariff, but only revises collation values in its eTariff database.

## **I. DESCRIPTION OF THE FILING**

PJM has identified two areas of its Tariff where new records are frequently added, specifically Tariff, Schedule 12-Appendices and Tariff, Attachment H, that have run out of room

between collation values under the eTariff XML schema. Because the tariff record collation value determines the position of the record in the Tariff, PJM would be limited in its ability to file additional records to its Tariff in these specified areas in the appropriate sequence.<sup>4</sup> Without a re-collation of these areas of the Tariff, PJM would have to insert new tariff records out of order in between other pre-existing records.

The following tables show which tariff records will be re-collated (as shaded in grey) in the two identified areas of the Tariff:

## II. REQUEST FOR WAIVER

PJM respectfully requests that the Commission grant PJM waiver of the prior notice requirement in section 35.11 of the Commission's regulations<sup>5</sup> to the extent necessary to allow an effective date of April 18, 2019, which is one day after the submission of this filing. Good cause exists to waive the prior notice requirements because PJM is not submitting revisions to its Tariff on file with the Commission as part of this proceeding and is only revising collation values in its eTariff database.<sup>6</sup>
