On August 23, 2018, you filed, on behalf of the PJM Interconnection L.L.C., revisions to the PJM Open Access Transmission Tariff, Attachment K-Appendix and Amended and Restated Operating Agreement, Schedule 1, section 7.3.9. You state that the revisions would allow the defaulting member's current period FTR positions to proceed directly to settlement for the time period of August 24, 2018 through November 30, 2018.

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation – East, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307, your submittal is accepted for filing, effective on August 24, 2018, as requested.

The filing was noticed on August 24, 2018, with comments, interventions and protests due on or before September 13, 2018. Granting late interventions at this stage of the proceeding will not disrupt the proceeding or place additional burdens on existing parties.
