On May 28, 2019, PJM Interconnection, L.L.C. (PJM) submitted a compliance filing containing modifications to its Open Access Transmission Tariff and the Amended and Restated Operating Agreement, as directed by the Commission in its order issued on April 29, 2019.¹ Specifically, PJM submitted additional revisions to its Fuel Cost Policy penalty provisions and also clarified certain provisions pertaining to the rules of offer parameter flexibility for Flexible Resources.

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation – East, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307, your submittal is accepted for filing, effective April 29, 2019, as requested.²

The filing was noticed on May 28, 2019, with comments, interventions, and protests due on or before June 18, 2019. Pursuant to Rule 214 (18 C.F.R. § 385.214 (2018)), to the extent that any timely filed motions to intervene and any motion to intervene out-of-time were filed before the issuance date of this order, such interventions are granted. Granting late interventions at this stage of the proceeding will not disrupt the proceeding or place additional burdens on existing parties.
