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Reference: Compliance Filing Regarding Price Responsive Demand Rules

On January 28, 2020, you filed, pursuant to a December 30, 2019 Commission order,¹ a compliance filing that revises the PJM Interconnection, L.L.C. (PJM) Open Access Transmission Tariff to clarify that Price Responsive Demand (PRD) is not eligible to receive bonus Performance Payments during a Performance Assessment Interval (PAI) when the PRD Curve associated with the PRD registration has a price point above the real-time Locational Marginal Price recorded during the PAI.²

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation – East, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307, your submittal is accepted for filing, effective December 30, 2019, as requested.

The filing was noticed on January 28, 2020, with comments, interventions, and protests due on or before February 18, 2020. Pursuant to Rule 214 (18 C.F.R. § 385.214 (2019)), to the extent that any timely filed motions to intervene and any motion to intervene out-of-time were filed before the issuance date of this order, such interventions are granted. Granting late interventions at this stage of the proceeding will not disrupt the proceeding or place additional burdens on existing parties.
