Re: PJM Interconnection L.L.C., Docket No. ER19-105-002 Compliance Filing to Correct Effective Date

Dear Secretary Bose:

In compliance with the April 15, 2019 Order¹ of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("Commission") in the above referenced proceeding, PJM Interconnection, L.L.C. ("PJM") hereby submits this compliance filing to correct the metadata effective date for the record submitted in Docket No. ER19-105-002.² The metadata effective date is being corrected, in the eTariff metadata, from the effective date of December 12, 2018, to the effective date of January 17, 2019, as amended in PJM's Amendment to Extend Time for Action filed on October 26, 2018.³

I. BACKGROUND

On October 12, 2018, pursuant to section 205 of the Federal Power Act⁴, PJM filed its quadrennial revisions of the Variable Resource Requirement ("VRR") Curve used in the Reliability Pricing Model ("RPM"). Subsequently, PJM filed an Amendment to Extend Time for

Action, consisting of a non-substantive amendment to the October 12, 2018 filing with a new proposed effective date of January 17, 2019, solely for the purpose of extending the time for interested parties to submit comments and for Commission action. Thereafter, on January 15, 2019, Commission Staff issued a deficiency letter ("Deficiency Letter") requesting additional information regarding PJM's filing. PJM submitted its response on February 14, 2019 ("Deficiency Letter Response").

The eTariff record submitted in the Deficiency Letter Response, in Docket No. ER19-105-002, included an effective date of December 12, 2018 in the eTariff metadata, the originally requested effective date. In the April 15 Order, the Commission directed PJM to submit this compliance filing to revise the metadata effective date of the eTariff record submitted in the Deficiency Letter Response to January 17, 2019.

II. SATISFACTION OF THE COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS OF THE APRIL 15 ORDER

In compliance with the Commission's April 15 Order,⁵ PJM submits this filing to revise the metadata contained within Tariff, Definitions, O-P-Q, from an effective date of December 12, 2018 to an a effective date of January 17, 2019. The metadata contained within the other sections already reflects the January 17, 2019 date, so revisions to the other sections are not necessary.

III. EFFECTIVE DATE

Consistent with the April 15 Order, the effective date for the changes herein is January 17, 2019.
