and PJM Interconnection, L.L.C.*

Dear Secretary Reese:

Pursuant to section 205 of the Federal Power Act¹ and Order No. 714,² PJM Interconnection, L.L.C. (“PJM”) hereby respectfully submits this Certificate of Concurrence with respect to a Cost Recovery and Funding Agreement (“Agreement”) between Midcontinent Independent System Operator, Inc. (“MISO”), Commonwealth Edison Company (“ComEd”), and PJM Interconnection, L.L.C. (“PJM”). MISO filed the Agreement as a Rate Schedule under its tariff in Docket No. ER26-1676-000, and ComEd filed the Agreement as a Rate Schedule under its tariff in Docket No. ER26-1683-000. MISO and ComEd requested a June 1, 2026 effective date for the Agreement.

PJM is also a party to the Agreement, but in lieu of submitting the Agreement, pursuant to sections 35.1(a) and 131.52 of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission’s

(“Commission” or “FERC”) regulations,³ in Attachment A to this letter PJM is submitting the Certificate of Concurrence to the Agreement as filed by both MISO and ComEd. Consistent with the requests of MISO and ComEd, PJM requests a June 1, 2026 effective date for the Certificate of Concurrence. The Certificate of Concurrence identifies both MISO and ComEd as the designated filers, with the relevant information about their filing of the Agreement.⁴

I. OVERVIEW OF AGREEMENT

As explained more fully in MISO’s and ComEd’s filings, the Agreement provides a contractual mechanism for: (i) the funding by MISO; (ii) the construction and operation by ComEd; and (iii) for operational control by PJM of certain transmission facilities included in, and/or associated with, MISO’s Long-Range Transmission Planning (“LRTP”) Tranche 2.1 (“MISO-Requested Facilities”), as approved by the MISO Board of Directors (“MISO Board”) in December 2024.⁵ Under the Agreement, MISO will fund the MISO-Requested Facilities specified in the Agreement, and ComEd will construct, own and operate the MISO-Requested Facilities, which will be located in the PJM Region and will be placed under PJM’s functional control once completed. The Agreement provides that no costs for the MISO-Requested Facilities may be allocated to customers in the PJM Region.
