Dear Mr. Eckenrod:

On November 23, 2015, PJM Interconnection, L.L.C. (PJM), filed revisions to Section 4.2 of the PJM Open Access Transmission Tariff<sup>1</sup> to comply with a Commission order issued on September 24, 2015.<sup>2</sup> PJM's filing satisfactorily complies with the September 24 Order.

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation – East, under 18 C.F.R. §375.307, your submittal is accepted for filing, effective May 15, 2015.

The filing was noticed on November 23, 2015, with comments, interventions, and protests due on or before December 14, 2015. Pursuant to Rule 214 (18 C.F.R. § 385.214 (2015)), to the extent that any timely filed motions to intervene and any motion to intervene out-of-time were filed before the issuance date of this order, such interventions are granted. Granting late interventions at this stage of the proceeding will not disrupt the proceeding or place additional burdens on existing parties.
