Reference: Revisions to the Open Access Transmission Tariff and the Amended and Restated Operating Agreement of PJM Interconnection, L.L.C.

Dear Mr. Shparber:

On September 1, 2016, PJM Interconnection, L.L.C. (PJM) filed revisions to the PJM Open Access Transmission Tariff and the Amended and Restated Operating Agreement of PJM Interconnection, L.L.C.<sup>1</sup> to (1) allow a Market Seller to request certain types of exceptions to the parameter limited schedule (PLS) values that otherwise would apply to a generating unit for an operational constraint that the Market Seller only becomes aware of after the specified deadline for requesting such types of PLS exceptions for a Delivery Year, (2) clarify the rules regarding PLS values and PLS exceptions for jointly owned generating units, and (3) make other clarifying changes.

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation – East, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307, your submittal is accepted for filing, effective October 31, 2016, as requested.

The filing was noticed on September 1, 2016, with comments, interventions, and protests due on or before September 22, 2016. Pursuant to Rule 214 (18 C.F.R. §

385.214 (2016)), to the extent that any timely filed motions to intervene and any motion to intervene out-of-time were filed before the issuance date of this order, such interventions are granted. Granting late interventions at this stage of the proceeding will not disrupt the proceeding or place additional burdens on existing parties.

This acceptance for filing shall not be construed as constituting approval of the referenced filing or of any rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, or practice affecting such rate or service contained in your filing; nor shall such acceptance be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation associated therewith; and such acceptance is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against PJM.

This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
