Dear Mr. Eckenrod:

PJM Interconnection, L.L.C.'s (PJM) submittal is accepted for filing, effective March 1, 2011, as requested.

On December 22, 2010, you filed revisions to PJM's calculation of Peak Market Activity (PMA). You state that these revised calculations of PMA will more accurately reflect relevant market activity, and that the determination of a Participant's transaction activity for all PJM markets and services shall not exceed the greatest amount invoiced in any one rolling one, two or three week period in the prior 52 weeks.

The filing was noticed on December 22, 2010, with comments due on or before January 12, 2011. Pursuant to Rule 214 (18 C.F.R. § 385.214 (2010)), all timely filed motions to intervene and any motion to intervene out-of-time filed before the issuance date of this order are granted. No protests or adverse comments were filed.

This action is taken pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation – East, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307.

This acceptance for filing shall not be construed as constituting approval of the referenced filing or of any rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, or practice affecting such rate or service contained in your filing; nor shall such acceptance be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation associated

therewith; and such acceptance is without prejudice to any findings or order which have been or any which may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against your company.

This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
