Dear Ms. Tribulski:

On January 9, 2018, PJM Interconnection, LLC (PJM) submitted changes to its Open Access Transmission Tariff (OATT).<sup>1</sup> PJM states that these changes reinstate certain OATT provisions in compliance with a previous Commission order in this docket.<sup>2</sup> Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation – East, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307, the submittal is accepted for filing, effective December 8, 2017, as requested.

The filing was noticed on January 10, 2018, with comments, interventions, and protests due on or before January 30, 2018. Dominion Resources Services, Inc. timely filed comments in support of PJM's filing. Pursuant to Rule 214 (18 C.F.R. § 385.214 (2017)), to the extent that any timely filed motions to intervene and any motion to intervene out-of-time were filed before the issuance date of this

order, such interventions are granted. Granting late interventions at this stage of the proceeding will not disrupt the proceeding or place additional burdens on existing parties.

This acceptance for filing shall not be construed as constituting approval of the referenced filing or of any rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, or practice affecting such rate or service contained in your filing; nor shall such acceptance be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation associated therewith; and such acceptance is without prejudice to any findings or orders that have been or may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against PJM.

This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
