Dear Ms. Hugee:

On February 21, 2012, you filed on behalf of PJM Interconnection, L.L.C. (PJM) revisions to Section 1.2A.2 of Schedule 1 of the Amended and Restated Operating Agreement (Operating Agreement), Section 14A.2 of the Operating Agreement, Section 1.2A.2 of Attachment K-Appendix of the PJM Open Access Transmission Tariff (Tariff) and Section 3F.2 of Part I of PJM's Tariff to comply with the Commission's January 19, 2012 Order.¹

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation – East, under 18 C.F.R. §375.307, your submittal is accepted for filing, effective June 1, 2012, as requested.

The filing was noticed on February 22, 2012, with comments, interventions and protests due on or before March 13, 2012. Pursuant to Rule 214 (18 C.F.R. § 385.214 (2011)), to the extent that any timely filed motions to intervene and any motion to intervene out-of-time were filed before the issuance date of this order, such interventions are granted. Granting late interventions at this stage of the proceeding will not disrupt the proceeding or place additional burdens on existing parties. No protests were filed.
