Dear Mr. Eckenrod:

On March 19, 2012, you filed revised versions of Attachment Q of the PJM Open Access Transmission Tariff (PJM OATT). You state that the revised Attachment Q reflects information that was previously accepted by the Commission but was inadvertently omitted during PJM's transition to eTariff in 2010.

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation – East, under 18 C.F.R. §375.307, your submittals filed in the above referenced dockets are accepted for filing with the effective dates as proposed.

The filings were noticed on March 19, 2012, with comments, interventions and protests due on or before April 9, 2012. Pursuant to Rule 214 (18 C.F.R. § 385.214 (2012)), to the extent that any timely filed motions to intervene and any motion to intervene out-of-time were filed before the issuance date of this order, such interventions are granted. Granting the late interventions at this stage of the proceeding will not disrupt the proceeding or place additional burdens on existing parties.

This acceptance for filing shall not be construed as constituting approval of any rate, service, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation or practice affecting such rate or service provided for in the filed documents; nor shall such acceptance be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation associated therewith; and such

acceptance is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or any which may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now or pending or hereafter instituted by or against PJM.

This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
