On May 20, 2022, PJM Interconnection, L.L.C. (PJM) submitted revisions to PJM Open Access Transmission Tariff (Tariff), Attachment DD, sections 5.14(h-2)(4)(B) & (C),¹ in compliance with the directives of the Commission's May 13, 2022 order.² The May 13, 2022 order directed PJM to correct certain omissions in restoring the Tariff language that existed prior to the May 2020 Order.³

Pursuant to authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation – East, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307 (2021), the submittal is accepted for filing, effective September 29, 2021, as requested.

The filing was publicly noticed, with interventions and protests due on or before May 27, 2022. Pursuant to Rule 214 of the Commission's regulations (18 C.F.R. § 385.214 (2021)), notices of intervention, timely-filed motions to intervene, and any unopposed motions to intervene out-of-time filed before the issuance date of this order are granted. Granting a late intervention at this stage of the proceeding will not disrupt the proceeding or place additional burdens on existing parties. No protests or adverse comments were filed.
