On March 26, 2013 you filed on behalf of PJM Interconnection, L.L.C. (PJM) clean-up changes designed to remove a series of obsolete references to the Interruptible Load for Reliability and Active Load Management programs in PJM's Open Access Transmission Tariff (PJM Tariff), Amended and Restated Operating Agreement, and Reliability Assurance Agreement Among Load Serving Entities in the PJM Region.

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation – East, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307, your submittal filed in the above referenced docket is accepted effective as requested.

The filing was noticed on March 27, 2013, with comments due on or before April 16, 2013.
