On February 27, 2026, Appalachian Power Company (APCo) et al.¹ submitted revisions to Attachment H-14B Part I, Attachment H-20B – Part I, and Attachment H-20B – Part II of the PJM Open Access Transmission Tariff to revise AEP’s Formula Rate Templates to reflect changes from Order No. 898.² APCo et al. requested that the filing be accepted effective January 1, 2025. Pursuant to authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation – East under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307, the submittal is accepted for filing, effective January 1, 2025, as requested.³

The filing was publicly noticed. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Pursuant to Rule 214 of the Commission’s regulations (18 C.F.R. § 385.214), notices of intervention, timely-filed motions to intervene, and any unopposed motions to intervene out-of-time filed before the issuance date of this order are granted.

This action does not constitute approval of any service, rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, contract, or practice affecting such rate or service provided for in the filed document(s); nor shall such action be deemed as recognition of any claimed
