

## **Y3-049 Edison #1, #2 & #3 138kV**

### **Generation Interconnection**

#### **Network Impacts**

The Queue Project #Y3-049 was studied as a 12.0MW (Capacity12.0MW) injection at the Edison 13 kV substation in the PSEG area. Project #Y3-049 was evaluated for compliance with reliability criteria for summer peak conditions in 2017. Potential network impacts were as follows:

#### **Generator Deliverability**

(Single or N-1 contingencies for the Capacity portion only of the interconnection)

No problems were identified.

#### **Multiple Facility Contingency**

*(Double Circuit Tower Line contingencies only for the full energy output. Stuck breaker and bus fault contingencies will be performed for the Impact Study)*
